IMPERIAL COUNCIL rated off the pace three wide, closed toward contention approaching the quarter pole, dueled gamely in the stretch and edged clear the final yards. Z DAY, quickly clear, moved over for position inside to rate the pace, was pressured into the lane and dueled gamely to the sixteenth pole before giving way; grudgingly. JOIN IN THE DANCE rated off the pace and just off the rail, moved to the flanks of the pacesetter near the quarter pole then leveled off in the lane. A CENTURIAN rated off the pace about the three path, steadied from between horses leaving the three eighths pole then flattened stride in the lane. PRIMARY WITNESS showed no speed while off the rail, bid angling five wide toward the quarter pole and finished evenly. DUELING ALEX was outrun. PRINCE JOSHUA chased the pace inside and weakened in the lane. TWO BRASH was bumped at the start then outrun. LOOKIN LEFT broke inward making contact with Two Brash then never factored.
