MYSTIC reserved in midpack off the inside, entered the far turn from the three path, continued to bid time travelling behind rivals, exchanged a couple of light bumps with LEIPZIG in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was maneuvered four wide turning for home, kicked in when given his cue, took charge leaving the eighth pole and edged clear under good handling. MISSINGLISALEWIS within striking distance and under a good hold while three wide around both turns, finished with good courage to take the place. PRINCE WILL I AM outrun towards the back of the pack, began to advance forward at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide into the lane, closed with good energy down the center of the course en route for the show. ALCOMATCH bobbed after lunging forward at the start, sat reserved and under a good hold, along with most of the competition, while racing along the outside, angled outward in upper stretch for optimal clearance and finished willingly to grab the last major share of the purse. CHEROKEE SPEED was taken in hand during the run around the opening bend, while in a bit between rivals, stalked the leader from the two path, remained between rivals around the second turn as well, lacked the necessary stretch response after being called upon. LEIPZIG contently took the inside route, slipped outward near the five-sixteenths pole, exchanging light bumps with the eventual winner as a result, failed to offer a serious bid during the stretch drive. CAUSE OF FREEDOM saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, swung wide into the lane, settled about five wide at the head of the stretch, rallied mildly subsequently to improve his position. AVIE'S PEGASUS leapt at the break, rode the inside for most of the journey, angled into the two path to clear a fading rival at the quarter pole, had no solid stretch bid. LIVIN LARGE forwardly placed four wide around both turns, issued his challenge for the front at the quarter pole, easily took over from the tiring former pacesetter, clung to a narrow edge with a furlong to go, but tired. YANKEE EMPIRE tracked the front runner from the pocket under a good hold, came up empty when set down in upper stretch. OSKAR HVAL three wide around both turns, gave way after going six furlongs. CEDROS cut the pace from the two path until the quarter pole and stopped.
